Submission Guidelines

All submissions must be original and not under consideration elsewhere. Papers will be **double-blind peer-reviewed**. There is **no Article Processing Charges (APC)**.

- **Language:** English only
- **Word Limit:**
 - Full-length Research Articles: 3000–7000 words
 - Review Articles: up to 2500 words

- Book Reviews: 800–1500 words
- **Abstract:** Each submission must be accompanied by an abstract of not more than **250 words**, followed by **4–5 keywords**.
- **Citation Style:** MLA 9th edition or APA 7th edition, based on disciplinary norms.
- **Zero Tolerance for Plagiarism:** *Kaleidoscope* follows a **strict plagiarism policy**. Any form of plagiarism will lead to **automatic rejection** of the submission.
- **Generative AI Policy:** Manuscripts generated wholly or partially using AI tools such as ChatGPT, Gemini, or others will **not be accepted**. Authors must **explicitly declare** that the submission is free from AI-generated content in the cover letter.
- **Formatting:** Typed in Times New Roman, 12 pt, double-spaced, 1-inch margins (templates attached).
- Contributors are requested to use endnotes rather than footnotes. Endnotes should be kept to a minimum and used only where strictly necessary.

Checklist Before Submission

- Manuscript file without name of author(s) or affiliation along with Abstract with keywords (250 words)
- Cover letter with Title of the article, Full name(s) of author(s), Institutional affiliation(s), ORCID id(s) (if available), Contact information, Declaration of originality, Statement that the paper has not been generated using Generative AI tools
